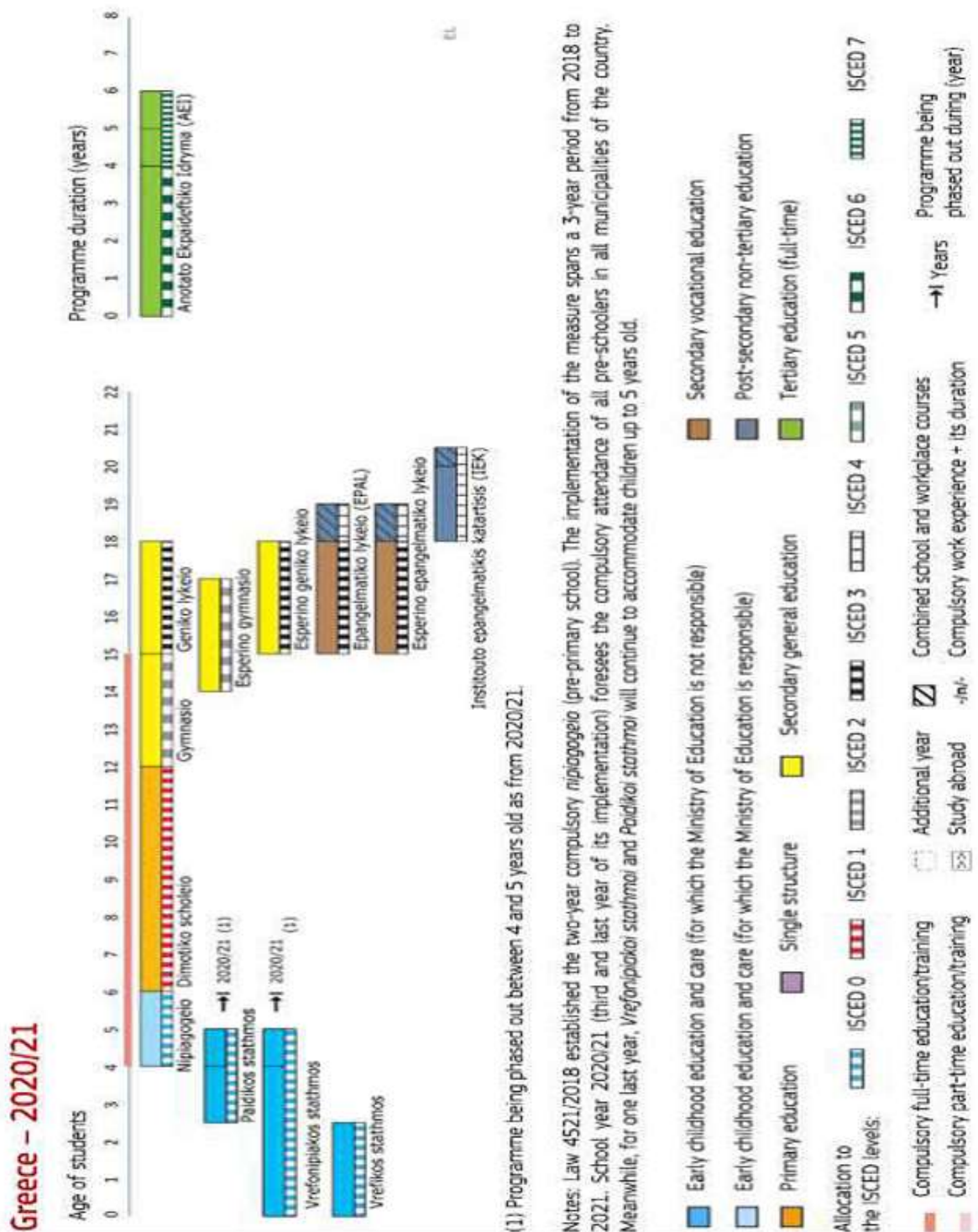

Notes: Law 4521/2018 established the two-year compulsory *nipiogogeo* (pre-primary school). The implementation of the measure spans a 3-year period from 2018 to 2021. School year 2020/21 (third and last year of its implementation) foresees the compulsory attendance of all pre-schoolers in all municipalities of the country. Meanwhile, for one last year, *Vrefonipiakiotai stathmoi* and *Paidikiotai stathmoi* will continue to accommodate children up to 5 years old.
