

George Karamfillis was born in Thessaloniki, Greece in 1979. He started learning bouzouki when he was eight years old. In 2020 he was awarded an MA in Teaching Music, School of Social Sciences Humanities and Arts, University of Macedonia. In 2015 he completed a BA in Music Education, Greek Traditional (Folk) Music, Specialization in 3-string Bouzouki, School of Social Sciences Humanities and Arts, University of Macedonia. In 2005 he completed a BA and integrated MA in Food Science and Technology, Faculty of Agriculture, Forestry and Natural Environment, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.

He started his career as bouzouki player and soloist in 1996 and since then he has worked with many well esteemed composers and prominent performers in music halls, theatres and venues all over Greece, including: George Dalaras, Melina Kana, Manolis Mitsias, Giota Negka, Mimis Plessas, Giannis Spanos. Over the course of his career, George has had a large number of television and radio appearances. Since 2015 he has been performing and touring with Foteini Velesiotou.

In 2000 he won the composition award at the 3rd Tsitsaneia Competition of Greek Traditional Music and in 2014 he performed at the Teatro Argentina an Opera House in Rome with soprano Sonia Theodoridou together with her husband and conductor Theodoros Orfanidis, and the Orchestra Mobile.

George has an extensive discography, appearing in various albums either as a bouzouki player or a composer. His first solo album will be released very soon.
