Christos I. Negkakis is a Professor of Accounting at the University of Macedonia. He graduated from the Department of Economics at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), while he holds a Master's degree and a PhD in Accounting from the same institution. He has taught at the National School of Judiciary and has collaborated with the Hellenic Open University and the Open University of Cyprus as Collaborating Teaching Staff. He has also contributed his expertise at the Department of Economics of Aristotle University (AUTH) as a Visiting Professor. Prof Negkakis is a Certified Internal Controls Auditor by the Institute of Internal Controls in USA.

Professor Negkakis is an elected Internal Member of the Board of Directors of the University of Macedonia. At the same time, he is the Head of the postgraduate and English-speaking undergraduate programs offered by the Department of Accounting and Finance. He has served as the Dean of the School of Business Administration from 2017 to 2023 and as the Head of the Department of Accounting and Finance from 2015 to 2017. Alongside his academic posts, Professor Negkakis was the President of the Unified Insurance Fund for Bank Employees from April 2006 to November 2010. Moreover, from 2005 to 2011 he was the Deputy Chairman of the Advisory Committee on the Deductible Expenses from Enterprise Gross Income and member of the Accounting Books Committee. He also served as the Chairman of the Examination Committee for the Professional Examination of Certified Public Accountants (2007-2009) and the Chairman of the Investment Committee of the Hellenic Pension Mutual Fund Management Company (2012-2017). From 1986 to 1995, Professor Negkakis worked as a business accountant-consultant. Currently, he is the Chairman of the Exemptions Board for the professional examinations of candidate chartered accountants and President of the Hellenic Finance and Accounting Association (HFAA), while he has also served in the past as the President of the Multinational Finance Society (MFS).

The research interests of Professor Negkakis focus on international financial reporting standards, international auditing standards, financial accounting, management accounting, corporate accounting and auditing. His scientific output is well cited and has been published in highly ranked outlets including, among others, the Journal of Banking and Finance, the Journal of Financial Stability, the International Journal of Accounting, the European Accounting Review, the European Journal of Finance, the International Review of Financial Analysis, the Journal of Economic Behavior and Organization, the Multinational Finance Journal, the Journal of Economic Asymmetries, the Applied Financial Economics, etc. Professor Negkakis has presented his work in international conferences such as the European Accounting Association Congress, the Multinational Finance Society Conference, the European Financial Management Association Conference and the Hellenic Finance and Accounting Association Annual Conference. Moreover, he is the author and co-author of nine books on Corporate Accounting and Contemporary Issues, Auditing and Internal Control, International Standards on Auditing, Internal Control and Risk Management, International Financial Reporting Standards, Managerial Accounting, Specialized Issues in International Financial Reporting Standards, Financial Accounting and Cost and Managerial Accounting.
