OPEN PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

The University of Macedonia and the Organizing Committee of the "Reflection of disability in art» (RoDI) Festival, invite all interested parties to participate in an open photographic competition on the contemporary urban landscape and its inherent restrictions.

“Imperceptibly they have closed me off from the outside world”

The competition is part of the activities of the "Reflection of disability in art” Festival and it aims to promote art from the perspective of visual impairment. Participants are invited to capture with their lens the restrictions imposed by the modern urban landscape that may compromise equal access to social structures thus depriving individuals of fundamental human rights.

Terms of participation

A. Photographs

1. The photographs considered to be of outstanding quality will be included in the Photography Exhibition and other related events of the Art Program of the 2nd "Reflection of disability in art” Festival.
2. Participation is open to amateur and professional photographers and persons who are 18 years of age and above.
3. Every participant/photographer will submit one (1) photograph which
3.1 is accompanied by:
 - the photographer’s contact information,
 - a description of up to 200 words,
 - a consent form attached to the e-mail of photograph submission, in case of photographs of people,3.2 meets the following technical specifications:
 - minimum size of 8 Mpixels,
 - jpeg file format
 - little technical post-processing3.3 Photographs submitted must have been taken within 2019

All photographs that do not meet above requirements will automatically be excluded from the competition.

4. The deadline for submission of applications for participation in the Photography Competition is the 30th September 2019.

B. PANEL OF JUDGES

The photographs submitted will be judged by a panel of photography experts.

C. QUALIFICATION for the exhibition

Participants whose photographs qualify for the exhibition will be notified by the University of Macedonia as to the exhibition program as well as the remaining festival events.

D. OTHER TERMS

1. The submission of photograph automatically implies the full acceptance of these terms and an affirmation of the truth and accuracy of the data.

2. The photographs submitted will remain in the University of Macedonia archives and will be used for educational purposes.

Participants submitting photographs concede to the University of Macedonia the non-exclusive right to publish them for promotional purposes.

3. The University of Macedonia reserves the right to publish information accompanying qualifying photographs.
