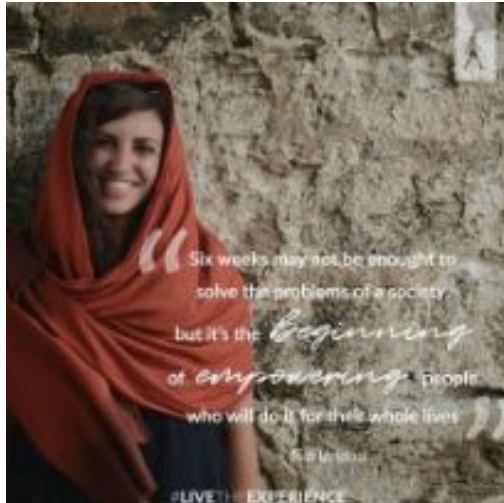




AIESEC is a global platform for **young people** to **explore and develop their leadership potential**. We are a non-political, independent, not-for-profit organisation run by students and recent graduates of institutions of higher education. **Its members are interested in world issues, leadership and management**. AIESEC does not discriminate on the basis of ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion or national/social origin.

Since we were founded, we have engaged and developed over **1,000,000 young people who have been through an AIESEC experience**. Global volunteer is a volunteering program of AIESEC that gives the opportunity to a young person to develop his/her **leadership skills** through a **cross cultural exchange**. The projects of Global Volunteer are based on the **17 Sustainable Development Goals** that the United Nations have established in 2015. The duration of the program is usually 6 weeks and there is also a program fee that is 160€.

Global Talent is a program that offers the opportunity to a young person to intern in a startup or a company **abroad**. Its target group is mostly young people from 19 to 30 years old and the duration of the internship ranges 1.5 to 3 months,
3 to 6 months and 6 to 18 months.

After this personal meeting, if you are interested in one of these opportunities, we can help you make your application for it, but of course we will be able to discuss everything about the following process in detail in our meeting.
